WRGY Powers Into 2026 With New Voices and Upgrades

It's been a busy and exciting year for WRGY, with activity flourishing on many fronts. The highlight of the past few months has been the addition of numerous locally produced shows, bringing fresh voices and new energy to our programming. We're thrilled to build on this momentum and look forward to 2026 as we continue to strengthen the technical side of our mighty community radio station!

Thanks to the generosity of our donors and local business underwriters, we're pleased to announce a series of significant technological upgrades. Construction is now underway on an auxiliary transmitter facility designed to keep WRGY on the air during power outages or when icing affects our antenna at the Saddleback summit.

We've also purchased new audio encoders to deliver our signal to the summit transmitter site, improving both audio reliability and sound quality. These upgrades will also enable RDS functionality, allowing song titles and artist information to appear on compatible radios.

Additional grounding work has been completed at the summit, and we're enhancing network security with the installation of new firewalls at both the summit and downtown studio locations. Our goal is to have the backup transmitter facility operational by next summer – if not sooner.

The momentum and enthusiasm surrounding WRGY this year will carry us confidently into 2026. We look forward to welcoming new show hosts, expanding our music offerings, and further improving our broadcast quality.

Thank you to everyone who has supported WRGY throughout this incredible year. The future looks bright for our community's radio voice – stay tuned!
